

FIRE RESTRICTIONS

Fire restrictions are in effect across San Miguel County, including US Forest Service and Bureau of Land Management property in the county, Town of Telluride and Town of Mountain Village (unless otherwise noted by an authorized agency):



NO FIRES including any open flames such as campfires, fire pits, controlled burns, charcoal grills and wood stoves.

- Gas and propane grills are permitted as long as there is an “on-off” switch for flames.



NO SMOKING except in an enclosed vehicle, trailer or building or on paved, hard-scape areas in compliance with applicable clean air acts.

- Smoking is allowed in Telluride Town Park only in designated smoking areas and only during Town-approved festivals.
- All cigarette butts must be fully extinguished and disposed of in a receptacle designed for cigarette butts.
- Reminder: as always, smoking cannabis is not permitted in public, including festival grounds.



NO FIREWORKS of any kind.

- Professional fireworks displays are permitted with cooperation of Telluride Fire Protection District and approval from County Sheriff and Town Council(s).

Please comply with the above fire restrictions as approved by the San Miguel Sheriff, Telluride Fire Protection District, Telluride Marshal's Office, Town of Telluride, Mountain Village Police Department, and Town of Mountain Village. Violations include hefty fines and liability in the event of a resulting fire.
